The status of all dams in Morocco, as of today, indicates that the filling rate of the Kingdom's dams is at 25%. The total reserves of all these dams amount to 4.03 billion cubic meters out of a total capacity of 16.1 billion cubic meters. This is the consequence of a significant rainfall deficit that has inevitably impacted the country's water reserves, highlighting an unprecedented water shortage in Morocco.

In Morocco, 88% of water is utilized by the agricultural sector, one of the main drivers of the national economy. However, with a per capita annual availability of 600 cubic meters, Morocco is already well below the threshold of water scarcity, placing the kingdom in a state of „structural water stress.“ It is imperative to take immediate measures to mitigate the effects of climate change and ensure sustainable management of water resources.
